INCOMPLETE ASSIGNMENTS	Incomplete assignments may impact student grades. Weekly grade sheets will be included in Wednesday folders. *Students and parents are responsible for checking PowerSchools regularly **A "0" entered indicates the assignment is late and no effort has been made to complete ***A "1" indicates the student was absent and assignment needs to be submitted
<i>The following behaviors will be noted on the behavior calendar and will result in immediate consequences and a full loss of recess.</i>	
INTENTIONAL DISRESPECT TO TEACHER OR STUDENT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Parent/teacher communication • After student/teacher discussion, teacher discretion regarding consequences will be used based on the severity of the incident.

BULLYING <i>(Bullying is when a student hurts or frightens a peer deliberately and repeatedly during school hours.)</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Parent/teacher communication • Detention, In-School Suspension, etc. as determined by severity and frequency
USE OF PROFANITY	Parent/teacher communication and Detention
HITTING OR FIGHTING	Parent/teacher communication and In-School Suspension

Notations on the Behavior Calendar – The purpose of the notations in the student's red folder is to inform parents of weekly student behavior (positive and negative). Parents are expected to sign in the "parent signature" box on the calendar each week. Folders will come home each Wednesday with the expectation that they are returned (signed) by Friday. **Calendars without a signature will result in loss of Friday recess.**

Detention – Detention lasts 45 minutes after school on Wednesday from 3:00-3:45 in the assigned classroom. An appropriate assignment will be given.
