Notations on the Behavior Calendar – The purpose of the notations in the student's red folder is to inform parents of weekly student behavior (positive and negative). Parents are expected to sign in the "parent signature" box on the calendar each week. Folders will come home each Wednesday with the expectation that they are returned (signed) by Friday. Calendars without a signature will result in loss of Friday recess.
