

# Spelling Menu



1<sup>st</sup> 9 Weeks - This board includes many different activities to help you practice your spelling words. Each week, choose a different activity to do for Home practice. When you complete the activity, put an X over it on your menu. When you have a Spelling menu assignment to complete at home, please complete your activity on a separate sheet of loose leaf paper to turn in. Don't forget to write your name and which activity you chose on the sheet that you are turning in!

<p><b>Word Art</b></p> <p>Go to <a href="https://wordart.com/">https://wordart.com/</a> and create a Word Art using all of your spelling words. Print and bring to school. Don't forget your name!</p>	<p><b>UPPER and Lower</b></p> <p>Write each spelling word once with all UPPER case letters, then once with all lower case letters. You will be writing each word two times!</p>	<p><b>Cursive</b></p> <p>Write each of your spelling words using cursive! This is a great way to practice both your cursive and your spelling!</p>
<p><b>Sort</b></p> <p>Sort your words into groups. You may use the sort that we practiced in your workbook, or you may create your own way to sort your words. Remember to label your groups!</p>	<p><b>ABC Order</b></p> <p>Put all words in ABC order on a piece of paper. Use anything you like to write with (crayon, marker, pen, etc.). You could also type this!</p>	<p><b>Rainbow Words</b></p> <p>Write each spelling word in a different color. You may use anything you like to write with (crayon, marker, pen, etc.)</p>
<p><b>Practice Test</b></p> <p>Have someone at your house give you a practice spelling test. Have that person check your work. Be sure to write any words that you miss three times correctly. Have the person sign your test and bring to school to turn in.</p>	<p><b>Reverse ABC Order</b></p> <p>Put all words in reverse (backwards) ABC order. Use anything you like to write with (crayon, marker, pen, etc.). You could also type this!</p>	<p><b>Consonants and Vowels</b></p> <p>Write each word once using blue for the consonants and red for the vowels.</p>
