

Spelling Menu



2nd 9 Weeks - This board includes many different activities to help you practice your spelling words. When you have Spelling practice, please complete your activity on a separate sheet of paper to turn in. Remember to put your name on your paper and label which menu item you chose. Each time you do an activity, cross it off this menu. You must choose a new activity each week!

<p>Rainbow Words</p> <p>Write each of your spelling words using three colors (blue, red, yellow). First write the word in blue, then trace the word in red, then trace the word in yellow.</p>	<p>3 Times Each</p> <p>Write your spelling words three times each:</p> <p>1st time: in print</p> <p>2nd time: in cursive</p> <p>3rd time: in another color</p>	<p>Cursive</p> <p>Write each of your spelling words using cursive! This is a great way to practice both your cursive and your spelling!</p>
<p>Sort</p> <p>Sort your words into groups. You may use the sort that is in your workbook, or you may create your own way to sort your words. Remember to label your groups!</p>	<p>ABC Order</p> <p>Put all words in ABC order on a piece of paper. Use anything you like to write with (crayon, marker, pen, etc.).</p> <p>You could also type this!</p>	<p>Typing Words</p> <p>Type each of your words 3 times each. You can change the font and the font color. Print it out to turn in. This is a great way to practice your Spelling and your typing skills!</p>
<p>Practice Test</p> <p>Have someone at home give you a practice test. Be sure to have that person correct your test. Practice any words you miss by writing them 3 more times.</p>	<p>Pattern/Focus Highlight</p> <p>Write your words in your neatest handwriting. Then, go back and highlight the part of each word that is the focus or pattern of your list for the week.</p>	<p>Make Your Own Word Search</p> <p>Go to www.puzzlemaker.com and click on Word Search. Enter your name as the title. In Step 2, change the numbers to 20 and 20. Type in your words and create your puzzle. Print and solve!</p>
