Allisonville, Crooked Creek and Spring Mill Elementary Schools.

- 4. What is the anticipated construction time frame for Phase IIb (subject to change)?

The anticipated construction phase timeline for Phase IIb will vary by school, however the overall timeline will be June 2019 through December 2020.

5. Will school continue during construction?

Crooked Creek and Spring Mill will continue normal operations throughout the construction phase with students in the buildings. Allisonville will move to the John Strange Elementary School building during the 2019-20 school year while Allisonville is under construction. The goal is to keep disruptions to a minimum. Safety and security for students and staff during construction is and will be our top priority.

6. How are Phase IIb projects being funded? Phase IIb projects will be funded with referendum bond proceeds as the result of support by residents who approved the 2016 school referendum.
