Positive Feelings  How frequently students feel positive emotions.	65% ▲3 since last survey	20th - 39th percentile compared to others nationally
Self-Efficacy  How much students believe they can succeed in achieving academic outcomes.	<b>47%</b> ▼11 since last survey	Oth - 19th percentile compared to others nationally
Social Awareness  How well students consider the perspectives of others and empathize with them.	<b>59%</b> ▼ 6  since last survey	20th - 39th percentile compared to others nationally
Supportive Relationships  How supported students feel through their relationships with friends, family, and adults at school.	89% ▼1 since last survey	60th - 79th percentile compared to others nationally





▲ 6 from last survey Favorable: 64%


## Q.3: During the past week, how often did you feel loved?



How did people respond?


#### Q.1: How sure are you that you can complete all the schoolwork that is given to you?


#### Q.2: When complicated ideas are discussed in class, how sure are you that you can understand them?


#### Q.3: How sure are you that you can learn all the subjects taught in your classes?


#### Q.4: How sure are you that you can do the hardest schoolwork that is given to you?




#### Q.1: During the past two weeks, how carefully did you listen to other people's opinions?


#### Q.2: During the past two weeks, how much did you care about other people's feelings?


#### Q.3: During the past two weeks, how well did you get along with students who are different from you?





#### Q.5: During the past two weeks, when others did not agree with you, how respectful were you of their opinions?












# Q.7: During the past two weeks, how much were you able to disagree with others without starting an argument?




Q.1: Do you have a teacher or other adult from school who you can count on to help you, no matter what?
