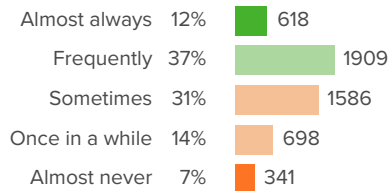

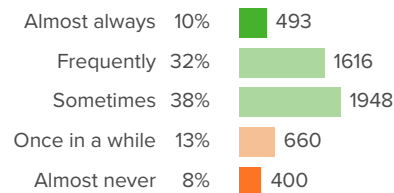
**Q.1: How often do teachers encourage you to learn about people from different races, ethnicities, or cultures?**

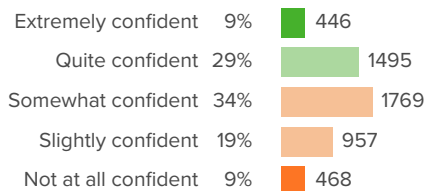
**Q.2: How often do you think about what someone of a different race, ethnicity, or culture experiences?**

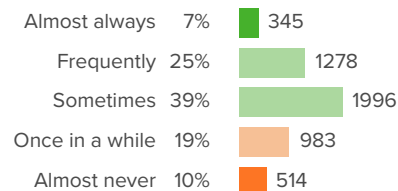
**Q.3: How confident are you that students at your school can have honest conversations with each other about race?**

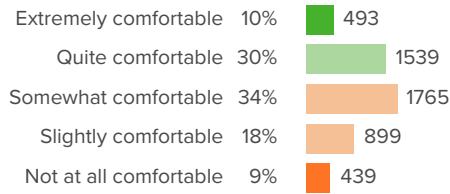

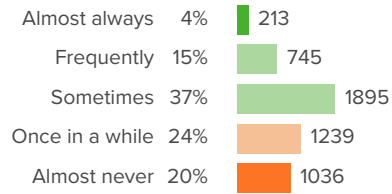
### Q.5: How comfortable are you sharing your thoughts about race-related topics with other students at your school?

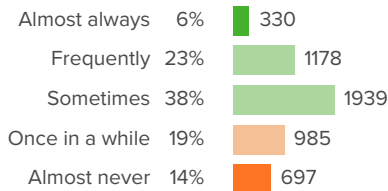
### Q.6: How often do students at your school have important conversations about race, even when they might be uncomfortable?

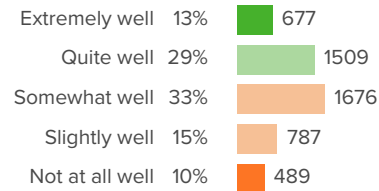
### Q.7: When there are major news events related to race, how often do adults at your school talk about them with students?

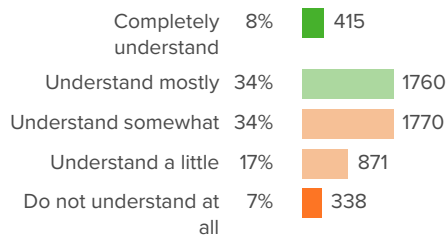

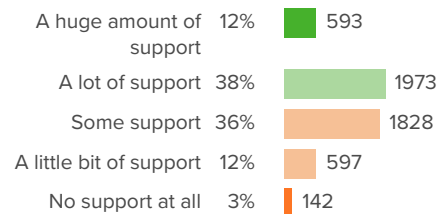
**Q.1: How well do people at your school understand the kind of person you are?**

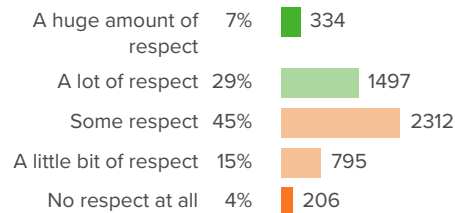
**Q.2: How much support do the adults at your school give you?**

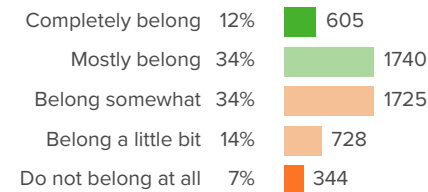
**Q.3: How much respect do students at your school show you?**
