As a reminder Tuesday, November 7th is a home based learning day for students.



THE ORANGE FAFSA FOLDER

Seniors recently received a bright orange folder in homeroom with information to help them file the form that all colleges use to determine financial aid: the **Free Application for Federal Student Aid** (FAFSA). The online site for filing the FAFSA, www.fafsa.ed.gov, opened on October 1 to seniors and their parents.

If you need help filing your FAFSA, plan to attend College Goal Sunday on November 5, at 2:00 p.m. There are several Indianapolis locations, with the closest being the Center for Leadership Development (2425 Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. St.) and Ivy Tech Community College (50 W. 


APPLYING TO COLLEGE

Processing forms are available outside Mrs. Stroke's office and on the south wall of the Guidance Office – near the flag. Mrs. Stroke gets your Pink Sheets, while your counselor gets your Yellow Sheet. Allow at least TWO WEEKS for your counselor to process your materials.

- PINK SHEET Submit one for EACH college application, with a parent/guardian signature on the first one. There is a \$1 processing fee for each Pink Sheet.
 YELLOW SHEET Counselor Recommendation
- YELLOW SHEET Counselor Recommendation Worksheet/Student Information Sheet. You can turn in a resume with the Counselor Recommendation in lieu of completing the information sheet.
- GREEN SHEET Teacher Recommendation Worksheet. Give this to teachers who have agreed to write letters of recommendation for you.
- TRANSCRIPTS If you are applying through the Common Application, your counselor will upload your transcript. Otherwise, request your transcript through www.parchment.com.





