FREE APPLICATION FOR FEDERAL STUDENT AID (FAFSA)

FAFSA is used by college and university financial aid offices to determine eligibility for grants, low-interest loans, college work-study programs and sometimes scholarships. Indiana colleges generally require the form to be <u>filed</u> by April 15 of the senior year, but some colleges have earlier deadlines. Be sure to check the priority date for your schools of interest. Applying after deadlines could mean loss of funds.

VISITING COLLEGE CAMPUSES

Seniors and Juniors are allowed two school days annually to make official visits to colleges. The process for scheduling visits is outlined on page 106 in the NC 2017-2018 Student Calendar Handbook.

The College Campus Visit Form, available in the Attendance Office, must be completed and signed by a parent, the student, and an administrator, and each of their teachers prior to the visit. Bring back an official letter from the college admission office verifying the visit.
