Mill Valley Middle School California Healthy Kids Survey 2015-2016

Date of Survey: February 25, 2016

Number of Students Surveyed: 324 out of 347

3% of 7th graders have tried one full drink of ALCOHOL

- 3% of students report drinking alcohol in the last 30 days
- 0% of students report binge drinking in last 30 days (5 or more drinks)
- 26% of students say alcohol is very easy, or fairly easy to get

90% of 7th graders perceive harm in frequent use of ALCOHOL (5 or more drinks per week)

- 62% of students think there is great harm in frequent use
- 24% of students think there is moderate harm in frequent use
- 4% of students think there is slight harm in frequent use
- 10% of students think there is no harm in frequent use

34% of 7th graders who have ridden in a car being someone drinking ALCOHOL

- 11% of students report riding in a car 1 time
- 6% of students report riding in a car 2 times
- 6% of students report riding in car 3-6 times
- 11% of students report riding in car 7 times

0% of 7th graders have tried MARIJUANA

- 0% of students report using marijuana in last 30 days
- 10% of students say marijuana is very easy or fairly to get

90% of 7th graders perceive harm in frequent use of MARIJUANA (2+ times per week)

- 73% of students think there is great harm in frequent use
- 12% of students think there is moderate harm in frequent use
- 6% of students think there is slight harm in frequent use
- 9% of students think there is no harm in frequent use

1% of 7th graders have used other ILLEGAL PILLS or DRUGS to get high

- 0% of students of tried inhalants
- 1% of students report using pills or other drugs (no inhalants)

36 % of 7th graders report being a victim of bullying or harassment in last 12 months

- 24% of students report being made fun of because of looks and way of talking at school
- 17% of students report being a victim of cyber-bullying
- 10% of students being afraid of being beaten up at school
- 9% of students report being in a physical fight at school
