Re: District Communication & Planning Timeline

We have prepared the following timeline to highlight the key steps in building awareness about your facilities needs and preparing for a potential bond measure in November 2020.

# Now – January 2020

- Refine facility plans based on survey results
- Determine plan for renewal or expiration of supplemental parcel tax
- Develop stakeholder outreach list
- TBWB crafts messaging about District's achievements and facilities needs, including
  - Talking Points
  - o FAQ
  - District Fact Sheet
  - District website content
  - PowerPoint presentation

### February 2020

- Schedule and initiate outreach to internal stakeholders in Mill Valley School District, including:
  - Principals, teachers and staff
  - Parent organizations and foundation
  - Bargaining units
- Schedule and initiate outreach to external stakeholders within the Mill Valley School District communities, including:
  - Elected officials
  - o Community organizations (neighborhood associations, service clubs, local businesses)
  - Key community leaders

#### March 2020

- Send informational mailer to all voters and parents to provide information about the District's facilities needs. The mailer will include a survey tear-off to allow people to provide their facilities priorities and feedback.
  - Corresponding survey will be posted on District's website and pushed out through email and social media
- Continue outreach to stakeholders and community organizations

### April 2020

- Continue outreach to district stakeholders and community organizations
- Compile and review feedback from facilities priorities survey



### May 2020

- Continue outreach to stakeholders and community organizations
- Mail second informational mailer to communicate about facility needs, report on feedback from facilities priority survey and introduce need for a potential bond measure
- Conduct tracking survey to refine measure and confirm support

#### June 2020

- Update messaging and plan to reflect community feedback and tracking poll results
- Continue to provide information to stakeholders
- June 10, 2020: Board reviews tracking survey results and first draft of resolution
- Update resolution to incorporate feedback, if needed
- **June 17, 2020:** Board approves resolution and votes to place measure on November 2020 ballot

## July - August 2020

- No later than August 7, 2020\* (88 days prior to election): District delivers adopted resolution to Registrar of Voters in order to qualify for the November 2020 ballot
- Send final informational mailer to all registered voters and parents announcing details of measure placed on the ballot by the Board and information on voting in the election
- Conduct training of District staff regarding role of District and staff during election
- Update district website with final measure information
- Transition to independent advocacy campaign
