



Our actual start date was Monday (Sept 28th) and we were so excited to see over half of each of our classes attend. We are still learning the ropes in the digital platforms and we also want to give the K-12 teachers time to get their own schedules down and let the families adjust.

After a week of seeing everyone, we will start sending home packets with materials you might need at home and then work up to activities in Canvas and our new curriculum. 
