Many colleges are not requiring you to take the SAT/ACT this year for college admittance. Please check with the colleges you are interested in to review their requirements.

Senior Year Checklist

- Review transcript: Are you on track for graduation?
- Register and take ACT and/or SAT
- Complete OSAC Personal Statements and Activities Chart
- Complete FAFSA or ORSAA: Opens October 1
- Review Student Aid Report (SAR) and make FAFSA corrections
- Begin submitting scholarship applications
- Begin submitting college applications; monitor deadlines
- Attend financial aid nights, workshops, and events

- Complete OSAC Scholarship Application
 - Activities Chart
 - Essays
 - Transcript
- Early Bird: February 15
Final Deadline: March 1 by 5:00pm

- Complete Oregon Promise Application, for students planning to attend community college
- Submit application to at least 3 colleges
- Apply for additional grants and scholarships offered by selected college
- Check your email and the OSAC Student Portal for notifications year-round
