


- 2. Reset your Citrix Workspace app to remove old addresses. Right click on your Citrix Workspace app in the system tray and choose "Advanced Preferences".




3. Click on "Reset Citrix Workspace", then again on "Yes, reset Citrix Workspace." Close the Advanced Preferences window.


