## NEWFANE HIGH SCHOOL VEHICLE REGULATIONS AS STATED IN THE STUDENT HANDBOOK

Our campus is under the jurisdiction of the Niagara County Sheriff's Department. All vehicles are subject to the regulations outlined below. Violations may result in the issuance of a citation and a suspension of parking privileges.

- ♦ All student vehicles must be registered.
- Student parking is permitted only in the north parking lot in those areas outlined in white paint.
- The area in the north parking lot outlined in yellow paint is reserved for faculty parking only.
- Vehicles must be parked properly within marked parking stalls.
- The speed limit on campus for all vehicles is 15 miles per hour.
- ♦ All drivers are required to observe and follow all traffic signs posted on campus. Vehicles must follow the proper traffic lanes.
- Boces (Allied Health, Sanborn, Medina) students may not drive to Boces at any time unless authorized by building administrator.
- Students who leave unexcused or take unexcused students off school property may lose their parking privilege.
- Students are not allowed to sit in parked cars at any time during the school day.
- Screeching tires or "drag racing" will not be tolerated.
- ♦ Students with irregular attendance (i.e. truancy, tardiness, etc.) may lose their parking privilege.
- Vehicles in violation of parking regulations may be cited and/or towed away at the driver's expense.

## **Additionally:**

- Parking permit tags must be displayed in front windshield.
- ◆ A fee of \$3.00 for one year or \$5.00 for two years will be charged for each parking permit to help defray the cost of the parking permit tags. A permit is required on every vehicle that a student drives. All permits will expire at the end of the school year.
- ♦ Students who drive more than one vehicle may obtain additional permits for a fee of \$1.00 per vehicle.
- ♦ Any vehicle parked on school grounds that is not registered may be towed at the driver's expense.

Notice of Search of Vehicles: Students are hereby notified that any vehicle parked on school grounds will be subject to search by school officials and/or police when school officials have reason to believe that drugs, weapons, or any other item, article, substance or object prohibited by state law or school policy is present in such vehicle.
