



New York District Kiwanis Foundation Scholarship Application



For Outstanding Community Service and Leadership

The New York District Kiwanis Foundation will present a minimum of 4 scholarships, not to exceed \$1,000 each, to graduating seniors in 2024.

The following criteria must be met:

- 1. The applicant will have participated in both school and community activities that demonstrate outstanding <u>community service</u>.
- 2. The applicant will have participated in both school and community activities that demonstrate outstanding <u>leadership</u>.
- 3. Applicant will have demonstrated academic success.
- 4. Applicant and/or family have a documented financial need.

Conditions of Eligibility- Applicant must complete the following:

- 1. Applicant must be nominated by a Kiwanis Club.
- 2. Submit a written application (see checklist) on or before April 15th.
- Funds can only be used for the following college related expenses: Tuition, room and board, and/ or books.
- 4. Funds are a one-time award and will be mailed to the College of Acceptance. Please Provide College student I.D. Number.

Method of Selection:

- 1. The scholarship award will be made based on community service, leadership activities, academic performance, and/or financial need.
- 2. The Scholarship Selection Committee will select the winners.
- 3. The successful applicants will be announced by the committee and will receive the award during an appropriate awards ceremony.

Application Outline and Checklist:

1. Community Service and Leadership

Attach a list of activities, both school and community related, in which you have participated over the past four years that demonstrate outstanding community service and leadership (examples of community service: volunteer positions, club officer, community service projects, captain of athletic team, etc.)

2. Essay

In a short essay (250-300 words), write about the importance of and your commitment to volunteerism, community service and leadership. Discuss your plans for college and your future goals.

3. Reference/Recommendation Letters

Please attach two letters of reference/recommendation from members of the community (not family members), or your school who have supervised you in leadership or community service activities. The letter should attest to your personal commitment to the community as well as your leadership skills.

4. Official School Transcript

Attach a copy of your official school transcript.

5. College Acceptance

A letter of college acceptance is required for receipt of funds.
