GAGA PIT! IT IS IN THE WORKS - BUT WE NEED HELP TO MAKE IT HAPPEN!

Do you know about Gaga ball? Your kids may have played this wildly fun and popular game from Israel - it's been called a "kinder, gentler version of dodgeball." It is played in a large, fenced area, usually an octagon, called a Gaga ball pit, and it has become a bit hit at schools and camps all over the world. Locally, kids may have experienced it at Camp Norwich, and several local schools are installing them.

For their class gift, last year's 5th grade class chose to give money towards a Gaga pit for Jackson Street! Our wonderful P.E. teacher Ms. Totty has been researching Gaga ball pit construction companies, and JSS parent Jenna Lanterman is helping to coordinate this. With funding from the PTO, we are planning to purchase the materials for an ADA-compliant Gaga pit!

This is wonderful and exciting, and we hope to have it by the end of this school year. To make that happen, we need parent volunteers to help - we are first looking for parents who can help us determine the best spot to place the pit and the right materials to ensure its drainage and durability.

Once the materials arrive, probably in late May, we will need a team of volunteers to put it together and in place, including installing the ADA accessible door. This will mean either a couple of afternoons or one weekend day of work, probably in late May or early June.
