if you're reading this on Friday morning: Walking School Bus on the bike path starting at 8:10AM behind Stop & Shop supermarket.

Also, today is the all-school assembly at 9:10AM – families are welcome. And then the Ice Cream Social at 6-7PM. Bring a picnic dinner if you'd like and join others on the Ms. Agna Playground. Ice cream is free, thanks to the JSS PTO!

BEFORE SCHOOL PLAY

I want to remind you or inform you that supervision on the playground before school begins at 8:35AM. If your child has breakfast before school, that begins at 8:25AM – Mr. Ames, the library ESP greets students at the door at 8:25 and leads them to the cafeteria. Buses arrive at about between 8:35 and 8:40. If they arrive before that, the bus/van drivers have the students wait on the bus because they know that supervision does not begin until 8:35.

We know that students come before 8:35 – we see students playing. It is important that you know that they are unsupervised. If you allow your child(ren) to play before there is supervision, we ask that you sign a release, acknowledging that you know there is no supervision. The form is attached to today's newsletter and is available in the office if you want to pick one up.

After school play on the playground is up to caregivers to supervise. By signing our release form, you also acknowledge that you understand there is no after school supervision either. We do have an afterschool program on site through the YMCA – they have their own schedule and supervisors.

Apologies for the "legalese" in this message but we are so concerned about safety as well as making sure you know what we can provide and what we do not. If you have any questions, please email or call me. Thank you.

FAMILY DINNERS

We're excited that Family Dinners are scheduled for September this year. These dinners are such great ways for us to connect with you, the grade levels. The JSS PTO underwrites these dinners and rely on donations as well. All dinners start at 5:30PM. There will be a basket for this when you come to the dinner. The dinner is simple –cheese pizza, salad greens, water, and cookies. We will include a sign up form in next week's newsletter – it's important to know how many are coming so we order enough of the food! At 6PM, the students go either outside or to the library, depending on weather, with childcare professionals until 7PM. 



Dear Caregivers:

As you know, Ms. Agna will be retiring at the end of the current school year. I am writing to advise you of the process and plan for selecting her successor. If all goes well, I hope to identify the next principal before the Thanksgiving break so that the new principal will have opportunities to spend some time working with Ms. Agna and getting to know the school community in the second half of the school year.

This is a time when principals and associate principals everywhere are working to build community and establish routines in their buildings. For that reason we will not initiate the search until October. Waiting until October also allows any new members of the School Council to be seated.

I have appointed the district Director of Health, Safety, and Equity Programs (Karen Jarvis-Vance) and Director of Curriculum and Assessment (Nancy Cheevers) as co-chairs of the Search Committee. It will be their responsibility to form a diverse search committee whose members play different roles within the school community, but who are unified in their commitment to the continued excellence of Jackson Street School. This group will review applications and narrow the field of potential principals to two or three finalists who will participate in several forums to be held at Jackson Street School on November 18th.

I will keep you updated throughout the process. This is sure to be an emotional time. It is my goal to ensure that the search is considerate of the school community and well-organized for success. To that end, I have provided the following timeline so that you will always know where we are in the process.
