#### **NEW SAFETY PLAN**

Based on your questions, I want you to know that the doors are alarmed to address the safety concerns brought by staff when a weakness in our security measures was revealed. We learned that a door had been propped open and not immediately discovered. The experience at Northampton High School, which also has alarmed doors, has shown that alarming exterior doors that are locked during the day is an effective way of keeping them shut so that all staff and students within the building are safe.

And to help with the dismissal procedures through Door C, we are designating the area on the blacktop closest to the garden (butterfly shed) as the waiting area for Kindergarten families.
