I wanted to send a few reminders:

Emergency/Health forms are due ASAP, even for those students remaining remote.

- In August, the state of Massachusetts mandated that the Influenza immunization will be required for all children 6 months of age or older who are attending Massachusetts child care, pre-school, kindergarten, K-12, and colleges and universities. We are requiring that of all students, whether in-person, hybrid, or remote. Please make sure to submit proof of this immunization please. This is required by December 31, 2020.
- Masks are required for all in-person learners at all times, except for meal time and mask breaks.
 It is a good idea to send your student with an extra mask-just in case. There are extras available at school if needed.
- Please use the Family & Student Checklist daily before sending your child to school.

- If you travel out of state for any reason and your student is an in-person learner, then your student must either produce a negative COVID-19 test taken within 72 hours of your return to Massachusetts or quarantine for 14 days.
