#### **TIMES**

Doors Open -8:30 am begin routes as soon as all of your members are ready to go.

Tag Day Ends – after all routes are done. You may do more than one route. Usually around 1:30-2:30 pm.

#### **DRESS**

- Marching Band Members Full marching uniform without Hats and Gloves. If it is cold or raining, you may wear raincoats and warm gloves. Stay in your full uniform, do NOT open coats and sash's.
- ? Orchestra Members Concert uniform (may wear tennis shoes). If it is raining or cold, bring an umbrella and wear gloves.

## **PROCEDURE**

- ? Come to band room, get route assignment, and meet driver.
- ? Take one can per person, about 25 envelopes and 25-30 tags per person.

## DO'S AND DON'T'S

- **?** Be Polite and Courteous
- ? No Horseplay, etc. Watch your language. You are representing Hoover!
- ? Do not open cans to get change for yourself
- **?** Give or leave a tag only for those that contribute.
- ? If no one home, leave an envelope in the DOOR not the mailbox.
- If they do NOT contribute, thank them for their time and leave politely.
- ? Do NOT go to a house displaying a tag.

- ? Checks payable to HIMA.
- ? Donations are Tax Deductible and you may sign the tag.
- ? Stay out of Large Ensemble Room.
- **?** Follow signs: (Beware of Dog, Stay Off Grass, No Solicitors)
- If a Dog runs at you DON'T run. It will chase you. Put hand in a fist and let it "sniff" you.
- ? Use Sidewalks, not grass
- ? Limit Cell Phone Use
- **?** Go in Pairs, and do NOT go into houses or apartment buildings.
