The President is responsible for the orderly conduct of the meeting and shall rule on such matters as the time to be allowed for public discussion, the appropriateness of the subject being presented, and the suitability of the time for such presentation. The Board, as a whole, shall have the final decision in determining the appropriateness of all such rulings. Questions or concerns relating to employees of the District will not be permitted. Such questions should be referred to the Superintendent of Schools at another time.
