PUBLIC PARTICIPATION AT MEETING

A BOARD OF EDUCATION MEETING IS A MEETING HELD IN PUBLIC NOT A PUBLIC MEETING – COMMENTS FROM THE AUDIENCE ARE LIMITED TO THE BEGINNING OF THE MEETING WITH THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS:

At the start of each meeting a thirty (30) minute question period shall be conducted during which time the public may voice their comments. Persons wishing to speak should identify themselves, any

organization they may be representing at the meeting, and the agenda topic they wish to address. A person wishing to be heard by the Board shall first be recognized by the President of the Board. The speaker shall identify himself/herself identify town or village they reside and precede with his/her comments as briefly as the subject permits. Comments should relate to school matters and will be limited to five (5) minutes per speaker. The President is responsible for the orderly conduct of the meeting and shall rule on such matters as the time to be allowed for public discussion, the appropriateness of the subject being presented, and the suitability of the time for such presentation. The Board, as a whole, shall have the final decision in determining the appropriateness of all such rulings. *Questions or concerns relating to employees of the District will not be permitted. Such questions should be referred to the Superintendent of Schools at another time.*

1. **Recommend** approval of the Committee on Special Education recommendations from their **meetings** held on 8/5/21 and (**CPSE**) 8/13/21, 8/27/21 (**CSE**).
2. **Recommend amending temporary appointment** of **Parnell Adam** as English Teacher, effective September 1, 2021 through August 31, 2022 and that he be placed on Step 1 Column 6 of the 2021-2022 salary schedule, with a salary of \$54,389.00, which was approved at the August 4, 2021 Board of Education meeting, **to a probationary appointment** for a period of four (4) years, effective September 1, 2021 through September 1, 2025, and that he be placed on Step 1, Column 6 of the 2021-2022 salary schedule, with a salary of \$ 54,389. **Mr. Adam has received an Emergency NYS certificate in the Certification/Tenure Area of English 7-12.** (Middle School)
3. **Recommend amending the probationary appointment** of **Andrew Banker** as Technology Teacher for a period of four (4) years, effective September 1, 2021 through August 31, 2025 and that he be placed on Step 1 Column 1 of the 2021-2022 salary schedule, with a salary of \$51,139. Mr. Banker holds a valid NYS certificate in the Certification/Tenure Area of Technology, which was approved at the June 2, 2021 Board of Education meeting, **to a temporary appointment**, effective September 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022 and that he be placed on Step 1 Column 1 of the 2021-2022 salary schedule, with a salary of \$51,139. (High School) This position is funded by the American Rescue Plan Learning Loss Grant. **Mr. Banker has not received NYS teacher certification yet.**
4. **Recommend rescinding the temporary appointment** of **Jacob Mossey** as Reading Teacher, effective September 1, 2021 through August 31, 2022 and that he be placed on Step 1 Column 3 of the 2021-2022 salary schedule, with a salary of \$52,439, which was approved by the Board of Education on August 25, 2021. (High School)
5. **Recommend** approval to increase Frank Langr, Music Teacher, from 40% to 50% (Salary from \$23,855.60 to \$29,819.50), effective September 1, 2021. The 10% increase of salary will be funded by the American Rescue Plan Grant.
