



Superintendent Announcement – 12/13/2020

The Northeastern Clinton Central School District is informing parents and guardians that an elementary student attending Mooers Elementary has been diagnosed with coronavirus (COVID-19). The district was recently notified by the Clinton County Health Department.

What we know:

- Grade 5 student at Mooers Elementary.
- The student was last in school on Monday, December 7th and was evaluated by their health care provider on Wednesday, December 9, 2020.
- Student rides district transportation Bus #80.
- Students in the affected Grade 5 classroom and riding bus #80 are to stay home and will be quarantined. Those families impacted have already been notified by the school team. Only the health department can conduct contact tracing. Families can also call the Clinton County Health Department at 518-565-4840.
- The district has provided the Clinton County Health Department with classroom rosters and bus lists for contact tracing purposes.
- All spaces the student occupied will be thoroughly disinfected.

All of our buildings, including Mooers Elementary, remain open. We send best wishes to our student for good health. Our district will continue to work closely with our local health department. Safety and security of our students is always our main goal. We also take pride in being transparent with our families while maintaining the confidentiality of those involved.
