Administration, teachers, and staff will remain on site and will be available.

NETWORKING WITH THE HEALTH DEPARTMENT

The Health Department informed area District Superintendents on the afternoon of Thursday, January 7th that positive cases and students in quarantine continue to surge within our North Country secondary schools (Grades 6-12). Based on this information, it is the recommendation of the Health Department that our older students learn remotely. We are following this recommendation and our district team will continue to meet regularly to review case numbers (within our district and county), hospitalization capacity, and health professional recommendations. **Updates regarding opening and closure plans will be announced weekly until further notice.**
