What we know:

- Grade 2 student at Rouses Point Elementary.
- The student was last in school on Tuesday, November 17th and was evaluated by their health care provider on Wednesday, November 18th, 2020 after reporting not feeling well.
- Due to the student being absent for several days no students or staff are required to quarantine.
- Students and staff directly working with the student have been notified as a precautionary measure.
- All spaces the student occupied will be thoroughly disinfected.
