Update #5 – 8/7/20

Update from Governor Cuomo

Today, August 7, 2020 the Governor announced that schools in the North Country can plan to reopen in September. This means that the Northeastern Clinton CSD will move forward with our three instructional model designs for in-person learning, remote learning, and homeschool instruction. The first day of In-Person classes for elementary and middle/high school students in Grades 6, 10, and 11 will be on Tuesday, September 8, 2020. Online learning for Remote students and those following the Hybrid Model in Grades 7, 8, 9, and 12 will also begin on Tuesday, September 8th. There are still many areas we are working on and we will continue to provide updates from the district and building levels for our families.

We understand that, during this uncertain time, many of our families have questions about the current reopening plan. To address those questions and keep our community informed, the **Northeastern Clinton CSD will livestream a Town Hall on Wednesday, August 12 from 6:00-7:15 PM.**
