**EVALUATION OF INSTRUCTIONAL STAFF** 

Evaluation of professional staff in the Northeastern Clinton Central School District shall be a continuing

process designed to help carry out the district's philosophy and educational programs for the benefit of

all students.

The purposes of staff evaluations are to enrich and develop effective classroom teaching. After each

evaluation is made, a full written report will be submitted to the Superintendent of Schools. A

conference will also be held with the teacher at which the teacher will receive a copy of the written

evaluation.

The purposes of the reports are:

to improve the instructional program; 1.

2. to assist the classroom teacher in improving and up-grading teaching performance; and

3. to assist the Superintendent in properly evaluating employees.

The procedures and guidelines for formal observations and evaluations of teachers shall be those agreed to with the employee organization representing the teaching staff and set forth in the colletive bargaining agreement.
