SPECIAL MEETINGS

In an effort to anticipate and respond to special circumstances which may arise during district operations, the President of the Board of Education or any member of the Board may call special and/or emergency meetings of the Board. Notice of such meetings will be given at least 24 hours before the date of the meeting to every Board member. If less than a week in advance, public notice of the meeting will be given to the extent practicable.

If, in an emergency, a special meeting is held before the twenty-four hour notice can be given, each member may be asked to sign a waiver of notice. If all members are present, however, the twenty-four hour notice may be waived by unanimous action. No other business than that for which the meeting was called shall be considered except by unanimous consent of the members present. Formal action may be taken at a Special Board meeting. Minutes shall be kept. Special Board meetings are open to the public.
