

EARLY GRADUATION

Early graduation may be accomplished with parental approval and upon notice to the guidance department and school principal and approval of the Superintendent of Schools and the Board of Education.

All normal graduation requirements must be completed for early graduation.

EARLY GRADUATION REGULATION

1. The student must have earned a minimum of twelve units of credit following completion of the regular sophomore year and have a four-semester cumulative average of 85% or higher.
2. Upon attainment of the preceding criterion, but no later than June 30th following the student's sophomore year, the student will submit a letter to the Superintendent of Schools requesting acceleration and stating the reasons for such request.
3. The Guidance Department and the Building Principal will then provide the Superintendent with relevant data, including the student's transcript, projected final year subject selections, and date of birth. Additionally, evaluations will be submitted from each of the students' teachers.
4. The Board of Education will render an approval or a rejection of the request for acceleration. A rejection will be considered final.
5. Any request for acceleration approved by the Board will be understood to be conditional, and subject to subsequent review of the student's academic performance following a five-week probationary period in the fall term. The Board will then render final approval or rejection.
6. Parental approval, in writing must accompany the student's request, under separate cover.
7. The Board reserves the right to adjudicate any request deemed to be of a hardship nature.

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
