COCURRICULAR AND EXTRACURRICULAR PROGRAMS

The Board of Education recognizes the educational values inherent in student participation in district extracurricular programs. Programs should be open to all students and further develop students interests in school-related areas, community projects, athletics and music.

Recognizing that student activities are a part of the school program, the following are the criteria which all student activity programs must meet:

- 1. student activities must have educational value;
- 2. curricular offerings in the schools; and
- 3. student activities must be managed in a professional manner and sponsored by a faculty advisor.

COCURRICULAR AND EXTRACURRICULAR PROGRAMS REGULATION

All students are welcome and encouraged to attend after-school activities, sporting events, etc. The following guidelines must be followed:

- 1. Students are to have school supervision for any activity in which they are participating or attending after school hours. If such supervision is not available, then the activity may not occur.
- 2. Students are expected to make their own arrangements at home when it is necessary to return for any practice or school- sponsored activity after the school day. Students may not be at school after hours unsupervised. It is the students' responsibility to make the necessary transportation arrangements to return to the school for the sponsored activity or event to be attended.
- 3. Where applicable, the late bus or team bus is to be used to return home at the conclusion of the activity.
- 4. Students not in attendance during the regular school day may not participate in any event that day without the approval of the Building Principal.
