STUDENT SOCIAL EVENTS REGULATION

School Dances

Formal and semi-formal dances are to be limited to two or three per year. If informal dances are allowed, the following are the guidelines to be followed:

- 1. dances are to be held from 8:00 p.m. to 11:00 p.m. only;
- 2. three volunteer teachers must be present and it is up to the students to get this agreement in writing;
- only Northeastern Clinton Central students in grades 7-12 may attend dances; however, guests may be admitted with prior permission of the High School Principal;
- 4. once a student exits the building without supervision of a chaperone he/she will not be readmitted; and
- 5. doors will close for entry at 9:00 p.m.

Student sponsors will be responsible for the following expenses:

- 1. cost of the band;
- 2. cost of two custodians to stay late and clean up after the event (compensation according to contract);
- 3. cost of hiring police/sheriff's deputies to patrol entrance and grounds during the dance; and
- 4. cost for damage to any property of the district.
