TRAFFIC AND PARKING CONTROLS

The Superintendent of Schools is instructed to develop a regulation concerning traffic and parking controls on roads, driveways and parking lots accessory to each school and playground in the district. Such regulation shall take into account the need to protect the safety of all students, school personnel and anyone else on school property or on roads, driveways and parking lots adjacent to such school property.

TRAFFIC AND PARKING CONTROLS REGULATION

Vehicles on School Grounds

Only seniors, with permission slips from their parents, will be allowed to drive vehicles to school.

Students driving to school are to obtain "student stickers" from the Senior High School Principal's Office.

Students are to park their vehicles in the designated area in front of the school building.

Cars must be kept locked all day and the school sticker is to be placed on the lower right corner of the rear window.

The school speed limit is ten (10) miles per hour.

There will be no riding of bicycles, motorcycles, all terrain vehicles, mopeds, snowmobiles, or like vehicles on the walks, parking lots, front driveway or athletic fields of the district.

Students that ride bicycles to school are to come in the regular entrance way and park their bikes in the racks provided in front of the building. The Board recommends that students use bicycle locks to prevent theft.
