The Train

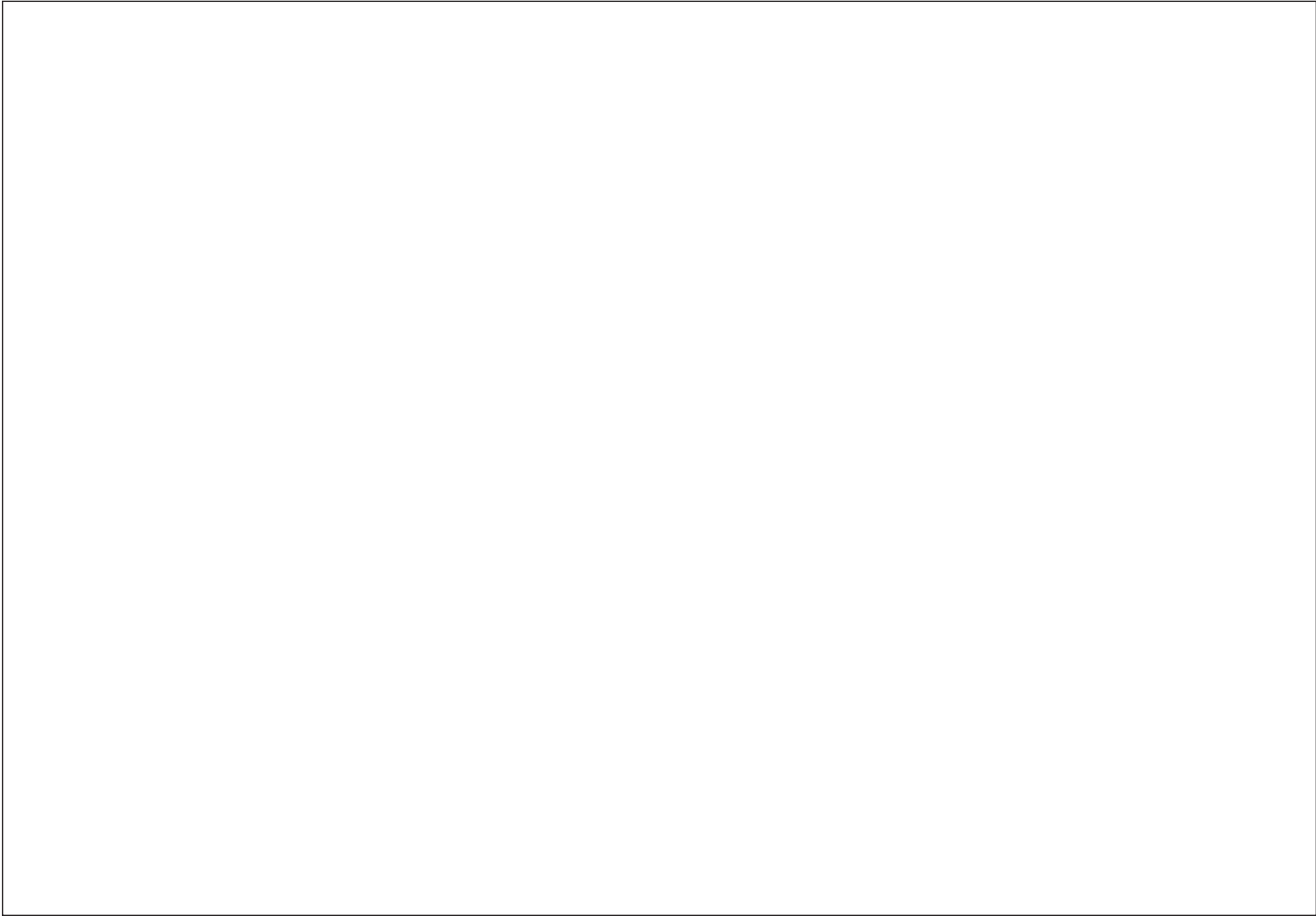
The choo-choo train is coming,
