My Dog, Rags

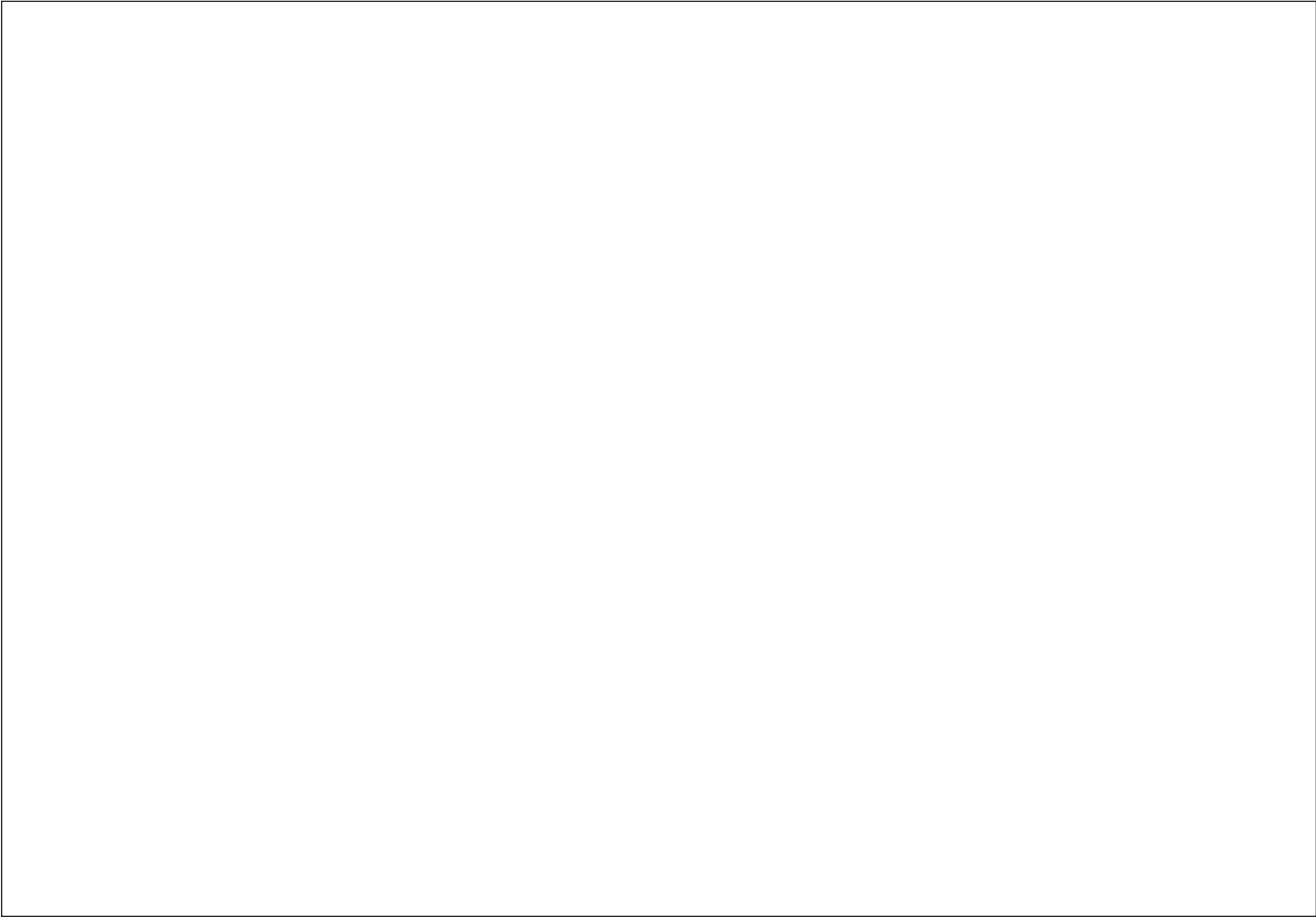
I have a dog

To see a lamb in school.



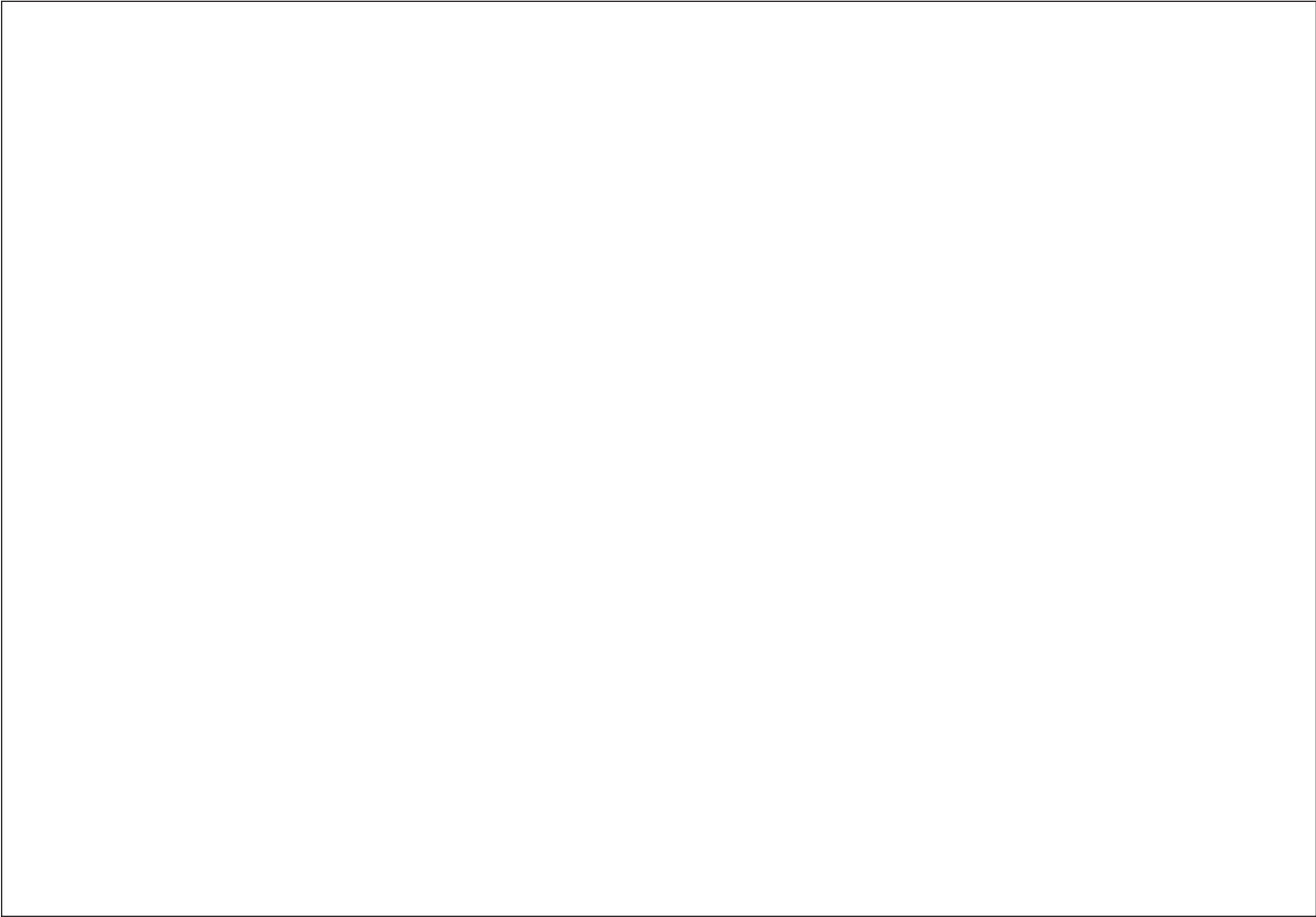
What Do You See?
