Oh, they live disgusting lives!

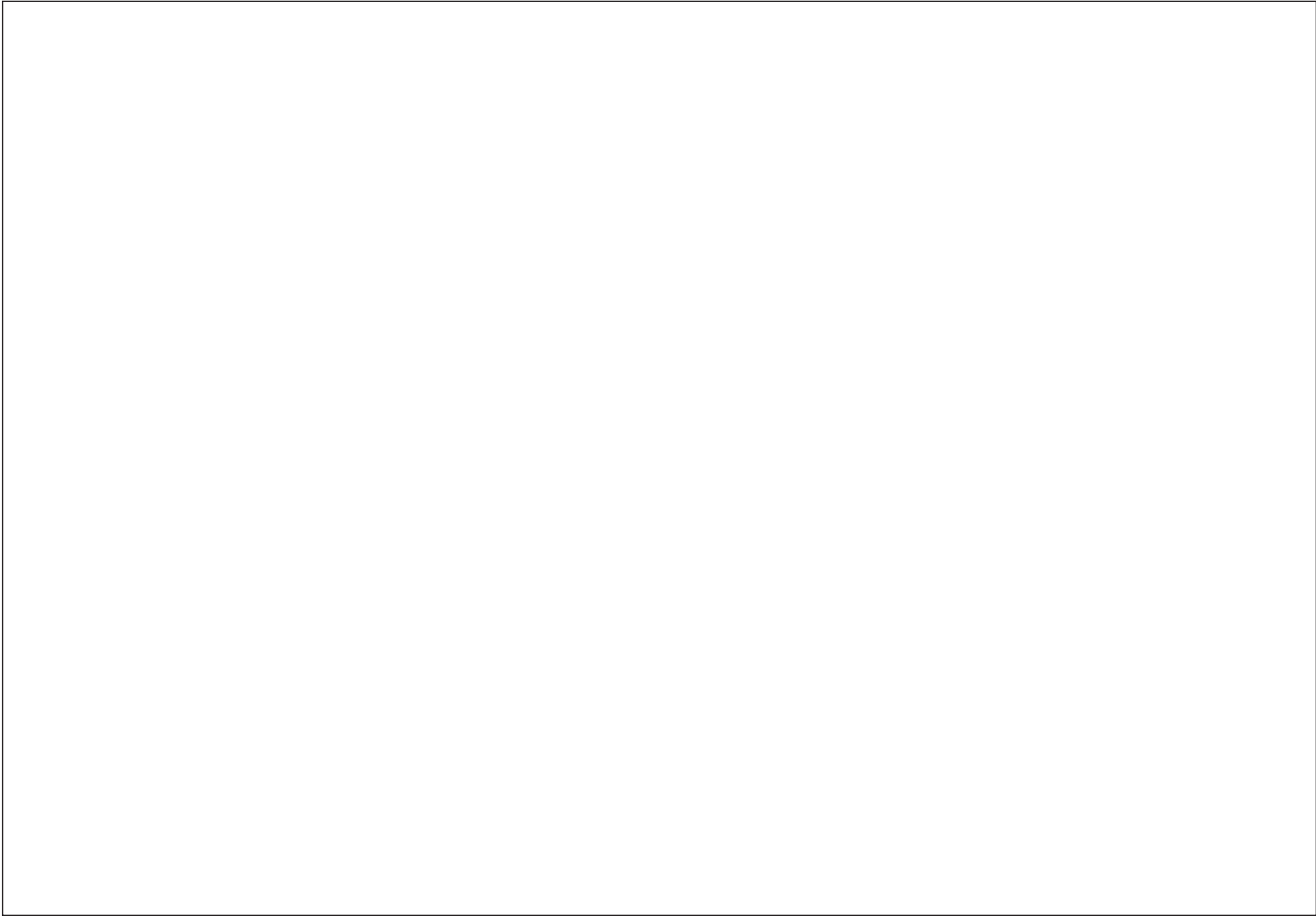
The Goops they talk while eating,
