## 10.13.22 Budget Advisory Meeting Notes:

Lois Standring (staff) kicked off the meeting by reviewing questions submitted to the question box at BAC 9.14.22 meeting. A Covid relief funding spreadsheet was supplied to the committee and Lois went through in detail. The 3 groups broke out into small group discussion to continue the work of developing possible solutions to bring to board. Groups reported out topics discussed:

## **GROUP 1: Attendance/Programs/New Revenue Streams**

- Supporting teachers and changing systems
  - a. Interns and new teachers support for them to come back and grow
  - b. More Professional development for all teachers
  - c. What teachers need is time-time to collaborate
    - i. Strong teachers = improvement
    - ii. During art, music, PE grade level prep

## **GROUP 2: School Configuration/System Efficiencies/Staffing Ratios**

- Unified bell schedule
- After school enrichment programs unify them instead of PTAs/outside groups funding each site
- How do you get sites more efficient?
  - a. Elementary schools go to 6<sup>th</sup> the two middle schools combine to one middle school with 7-8<sup>th</sup> grades

## **GROUP 3: Creativity with One-Time Money**

- Use state funding to pilot an expanded learning opportunity Program (ELO)
  - a. Students (before or after school) have the opportunity to participate in additional subjects
    - i. Teachers would get paid 1.2 fte
    - ii. Could be a concrete rationale for the Parcel Tax
    - iii. Offering families an opportunity for enrichment
    - iv. Program needs to make sense for each school site it would be at
    - v. TK-6 grades to start (state funded)
    - vi. San Jose MS started this year and already has 121 students taking advantage after school (6<sup>TH</sup> grade is state funded-covid funds are covering 7-8<sup>th</sup> grades)
  - b. Ongoing State funded money (not one-time)
  - c. Next step-what else needs to be known if this were to be implemented tomorrow?
- Organize some funds to use as a revenue stream to pay teachers to be mentors to new teachers coming into the District.
  - a. Induction program for new teachers in NUSD (Lois touched on this-similar to idea?)
  - b. More of a mentorship as a colleague-not someone judging/critiquing the new teacher
  - c. A model of care at NUSD
