### Welcome to Full Day Pre-K!

Snack – enough to be shared with 20 children. (ie. popcorn, pretzels, fruit, individual applesauce with spoons, cheese sticks, teddy grahams, cereal bars, granola bars or Little Debbie cakes) Each child is asked to supply a snack for the class once a month. This can be sent in at the beginning of each month.
