RE: Summer Learning Lab | Credit Recovery



Dear Grape Picker Families:

We are excited to launch year five of our Summer Learning Lab (SLL) which is an enrichment extension for students. The Summer Learning Lab and credit recovery is open to any 2024-2025 K-12 student who is currently enrolled in the North East School District; however, seats are limited. The Summer Learning Lab will run for four weeks Monday through Thursday from 8:30 a.m. and end promptly at 12:30 p.m. beginning Monday, June 16th through Friday, July 18th. Students in grades K-8 enrolled in the Summer Learning Lab will also be able to participate in an optional Friday field trip. Friday Field Trips are being made available through our partnership with Mercyhurst University STEM and Vine grant to offer additional experiences to enhance the STEM and Vine activities taught throughout the week. There will be no Summer Learning Lab the week of July 4th. Breakfast and lunch will be provided as well as modified shuttle transportation. All K-12 programs will be held in our North East Elementary School building. Please <u>read</u> the attached flyer to register your child(ren).

All district policies and procedures will be implemented. If your child is attending the grades 9-12 credit recovery program, we will be integrating physical activity and outdoor breaks as well. 

All K-12 programs will be held in our North East Elementary building. Breakfast and lunch will be provided to all participants.

- Students will be grouped by grade level and interact with their same-aged peers.
- Each day's schedule may include the following:
 - 1 hour of Specials Enrichment that rotates each week. Examples include:
 - Art
 - STEM
 - FACS
 - Tech Ed
 - Pool
 - 1 hour of ELA based instruction
 - 1 hour of math based instruction
 - 1/2 hour of physical activity
 - 1/2 hour of lunch and SEL Activity
- Classes will be taught by certified teachers and lessons will be project-based, engaging, and interactive.
- The additional instruction centered on the academic standards will set students up for a successful 2025-2026 school year.

- High School students will have the opportunity to participate in credit recovery during the summer to ensure that they are on track to graduate.
- Courses will be conducted through North East Virtual Academy with guidance from certified High School teachers.
