ELEMENTARY/MIDDLE SCHOOL GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

In order to recognize successful completion of elementary and middle school education, the Board of Trustees may confer diplomas of graduation from elementary and middle schools and from special day and evening classes of elementary and middle grades.

Diplomas shall be awarded only to students who have completed the course of study prescribed by law and the district. (Education Code 51402)
