PROCESS: With the guidance of a music teacher, your child will choose a piece of approved music that will be performed at the 2024 NYSSMA Festival.

Please note: Music must be listed in the current NYSSMA manual (33rd edition). Two originals of the music piece are required. One is for the student and the second is for the judge at the festival to view during the performance. Music stores frequently run out of music early. Be sure to purchase ASAP. Photocopies will not be accepted. See copyright section of the NYSSMA Manual for additional information.

Before the festival takes place, students are encouraged to practice on their own and to work with their music teachers and private instructors so that they may prepare for this important performance. Please be reminded that most auditions are ten minutes in length and only percussionists and students performing on levels 5 and 6 are required to have a 15 minute audition.

Voice Part – List the vocal part (ex. Tenor) on which you will be performing.

Solo or Ensemble – Circle the “S” for Solo or “E” for Ensemble.

All-State Audition – This option is only open to students in grades 10 & 11 performing level 6 and should be strongly recommended by their school instrumental/vocal teacher. **In accordance with NYSSMA regulations, students must be in the comparable school performing group during the year of audition and the year of participation in an All-State group.**

Level of Selection – List the music level that you will be performing. (Levels 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, AS)

Ensemble Partners – If attending in an ensemble, list the **first and last** names of the other individuals in your group. Please note that ensembles are only required to pay one fee (not one per member).

Accompanist – If you are using an accompanist list the name of the accompanist.

It is essential to the management and organization of the registration process that parents register their child as follows:

All registrations must be on the appropriate forms.

If your child is performing an instrumental and a vocal solo, they must register on separate forms and include separate checks.

If your child is registering for piano and any other solo festivals, they must register on separate forms and include separate checks.

Vocal forms must be returned to vocal teachers and separate instrumental forms must be returned to instrumental teachers.

NOTE: ENSEMBLE PARTICIPANTS should arrange to have
one member forward a check to cover the cost of each
performance of the group.

COPYRIGHT: It is essential that every student come to the
NYSSMA festival prepared with two copies of original (not
photocopied) music. If the piece has no accompaniment part, this
must be two identical original copies. If the piece has an
accompaniment, the combination of one solo part and its
corresponding accompaniment part (with the solo line included)
will suffice. Please check with your child's music teacher to
ensure your child is properly prepared. NYSSMA must adhere to
federal copyright laws.

ACCOMPANISTS: Accompanists spend many hours working
on the music both alone and with the student. The ability of the
accompanist can enhance the performance of the student.
Students should consult with their teacher in engaging a skilled
accompanist.

TRANSPORTATION: The music department will supply
directions to the festival site. It is the responsibility of each
student and parent to arrive at the festival site on their own. It is
requested that all students arrive at their audition site no later than
20 minutes before their audition time. Students having
transportation problems should notify their respective music
teacher so that they may try to assist them in arranging a ride.

MEDALS: The Oyster Bay-East Norwich music staff are
extremely excited to have your child participating in this very
special competition and hope that they will be successful in this
venture. Those students who receive high ratings will be
rewarded with an official NYSSMA medal.

**While students are not required to receive private instruction
in order to attend NYSSMA, it is highly recommended. Our
music staff can only provide limited support in this respect
due to the primary importance of regular classroom
instruction and the immense number of students involved.**
