What is the purpose of the Purple Sheet?

- Support for missed school.
- Accountability.
- Communication with families.

How does the Purple Sheet work?

- When a student misses a whole day of school, the day they return, a Purple Sheet will be in their homeroom.
- The student must connect with all their teachers to see what work they have missed during their absence(s).
- They will be required to stay after school the following school day until all their teachers have signed off that they have caught up from the day they missed.
- Example: Student misses Monday; comes to school on Tuesday (Purple Sheet given)- Stay after beginning on Wednesday. They will continue to stay after until the Purple Sheet is completed and turned into the Main Office.

What happens if a student gets caught up the day/night they receive the Purple Sheet?

They will turn in their completed Purple Sheet to the Main Office, and the student will not have to stay
after.

How are we building independence?

• We will scaffold the Purple Sheet system. Below are the supports per grade level:

Grade Levels

- Seventh Grade
 - Receive a Purple Sheet for every day missed; they must stay after school Monday through Thursday until all teachers sign off on the Purple Sheet.
- Eighth Grade
 - Receive a Purple Sheet for every day missed; they must stay after school Monday through Thursday until all teachers sign off the Purple Sheet.
- Ninth Grade
 - Receive a Purple Sheet for every day missed; they must stay after school Monday through Thursday until all teachers sign off on the Purple Sheet.
- Tenth Grade
 - Receive a Purple Sheet for every day missed; they must stay after school Monday through Thursday until all teachers sign off the Purple Sheet.
- Eleventh Grade
 - For the first three quarters, they will receive a Purple Sheet for every day missed, and they must stay after school Monday through Thursday until all teachers sign off the Purple Sheet.
 - If the student is on day 5 for attendance and failing, the Purple Sheet will be re-enacted in the 4th quarter.
- Twelfth Grade
 - O No Purple Sheet will be given unless the Senior becomes an attendance concern.
 - If the student is on day 5 for attendance and failing, the Purple Sheet will be re-enacted for the remainder of that quarter.
