- Violate school district policy or procedure related to harassment, intimidation, bullying, or discrimination;
- Incite an unlawful act on school premises or violate a lawful school regulation; or
- Create a material and substantial disruption of the orderly operation of the board meeting

Individuals wishing to address the board are asked to raise their hand to be recognized by the Board Chair. When providing public comment, please start by stating your name and address for the public record and you will have 3 minutes to address the board.
