There are several legal requirements for serving on the school board.

1. You must be a citizen of the U.S., a registered voter and reside within the Pioneer School District boundaries.
2. A financial disclosure statement must be filed within two weeks of appointment to the Public Disclosure Commission.
3. Neither the candidate nor a member of his/her household may be employed by the district or have any monetary interest in a contract held by the district that exceeds \$5,000, except:
 - a. When the director's spouse was employed by the district before the director's election or appointment to the board.
 - b. A director's spouse may be employed as a substitute teacher if there is a shortage of substitutes.

This appointment is until November 2023, serving on a school board demands a commitment of time. In addition to attending school board meetings, school board members are expected to study board materials in preparation for board meetings. The board meets for two regularly scheduled meetings each month. Meetings are usually scheduled for 6:00 pm on the second and fourth Tuesday. There will be special meetings during at times.
