Pioneer School District 402 Educational Programs and Operations Replacement Levy

On February 14, 2023, the voters within the Pioneer School District 402 will be voting on the replacement levy for the educational programs and operations of the district.

The state now requires the district to submit names of those stakeholders who are “For” the levy as well as names of those who are “Against” the levy.

The school district is soliciting names from voters who are “For” the levy and who are “Against” the levy. The document requires the name, phone number, email address, and committee name(if applicable), of those constituents who are “For” or “Against” the levy.

The “For”/”Against” document needs to be submitted to the elections office before December 16, 2022.
