<u>Business Operations</u> – Fiscal Director Chris Bishop shared the December 2023 budget summary and status report in addition to revenue and expenditure charts.

<u>Superintendent Report</u> – Superintendent shared a facility update, recognized recent donations from local companies in support of Pioneer Garden and shared the next community dinner will be in late February.

<u>Discussion Items</u> – Dr. Day moved to approve the Non-High Designation of Serving High School form as completed. Ms. Bechtolt seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.
