- Human Geography (AP) (H011/2) - Human Geography AP (Advanced Placement) is a year-long **college level** course. It fulfills the Ethnic Studies requirement for graduation. If you choose to take AP Human Geography, the health class may be taken during the summer, or postponed until another school year.
