Dear Students, Parents and/or Guardians,

The 2024 AP Exams will be administered from Monday, May 6th through Friday, May 17th, 2024 in accordance with College Board's schedule. Students who wish to take an AP exam must register **no later than November 3rd, 2023**. Students must register through both College Board's MyAP and the high school's Total Registration page. Students **MUST USE a personal email account** to register. Student **school district assigned email CANNOT be used**. Step by step directions can be found following this letter and on the Rocky Point High School website under **AP Advanced Placement**.

REGISTRATION INSTRUCTIONS:

AP Exam registration is a two-step process. Students must log in to their "My AP" dashboard and confirm with their teachers they want to take the AP Exam for each course in which they are enrolled. All deadlines and fees related to the administration of AP exams are in accordance with College Board policy and non-refundable. Late Test Order Fees, Unused/Canceled Exam Fees, Fee Reduction Eligibility, and deadlines are all determined by College Board.

Once students have confirmed their registration on their "My AP" dashboard, they must visit our Total Registration link. The link can be found on the school website under AP Advanced Placement or visit www.TotalRegistration.net/AP/334887. To complete the registration process, students must answer all of the required questions. Registration will not be complete until students have printed the pdf of the confirmation page that is provided at the end. We know that parents may desire to register their students for the exams. We strongly recommend that parents and students are both present while registering to ensure that the correct exams are ordered. The registration fees for exams will be \$98 per test. Students should complete one registration that includes all exams they will take.

The registration deadline is Friday, November 3rd!

Registration will be open from Wednesday, September 6th to Friday, November 3rd.

Students who are either enrolled or eligible to participate in the Federal Free or Reduced-Price Lunch Program qualify for a fee reduction. The cost for each exam for these eligible students is \$64. You will need to be verified to be approved for this fee reduction. If you wish to receive a fee reduction for your child, please be sure to fill out the appropriate areas on the online registration form. Students requesting this program must qualify and be verified.

AP EXAM REGISTRATION PROCEDURE

1. Registering for your AP Exams is an easy, 2-step process. For the first step, you will need to sign up for your exams using totalregistration.net. The Total Registration site is where you will pay for your exam and it allows us to communicate information such as exam times and locations to you and your parents.

2. For the next step, you will need your College Board log-in information to log in to myap.collegeboard.org. Log into your MY AP Dashboard and follow the instructions for exam registration.

If you do not remember how to log in to College Board, first try using the "Forgot Username and Password" links. If that does not work, you will need to contact them at 1-866-315-6068 for assistance.
