Included in the tax cap proposal is a 50% reduction in the non-mandated music program. The impact of this loss in the music program would be the following:

Elementary (reduce by 4 teachers)

Assign instrumental teachers to 4 buildings each

Assign one less music teacher to each building

Band, choir, and orchestra teachers to teach general music in addition to ensembles

High School (reduce by 1 teacher)

Split orchestra teacher between two buildings
