
Advocating for Sachem: Outcomes/H.S. Completion



Advocating for Sachem: Business and Career Technical Education

- Students can earn 3 undergraduate credits through Farmingdale State College for the following courses:
- College Accounting, Business Law, College Marketing, Sports & Entertainment Management, International Business, Retail & Fashion Management and E Business & Entrepreneurship.
- Up to 150-175 business students earn college credit in any given year.
- This provides Sachem students an opportunity to earn a CTE endorsement on their diploma.





Sachem Student Connection to The Business Community



- Citibank Summer Internship Program July August 2013 and July – August 2014.
 - Sachem is one of six school districts selected to participate.
 - Over thirty Sachem students applied for this highly competitive internship. Six Sachem Business students are selected each summer. These students gain professional experience in a business environment.


